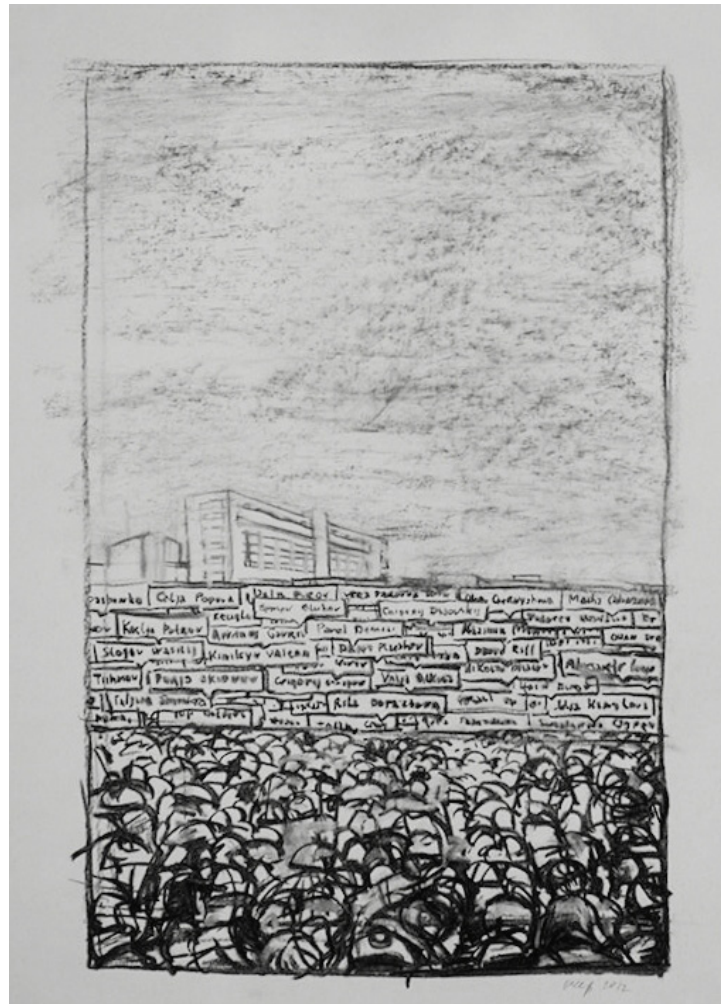


Olga Chernysheva is one of the few contemporary Russian artists widely present on the international scene. She works in a variety of media, including oil painting, film and photography; although it is with the latter that she has made the most distinctive mark on the Russian art scene. For the subject of her works, Chernysheva is drawn repeatedly back to scenes of everyday life and of real human experience. She considers 'monumental' pieces of art too harmonising to help her develop her work; she is more likely to be inspired by 'an article in a magazine, or a pop song played on a Moscow taxi radio'. For her, the 'exhibition space' is the street, where the experiences of her life, and of the lives of those around her, are played out, along with the reality of disadvantage and social tensions. Chernysheva shows the lives of ordinary Russian workers as they are, with a refreshing openness and lack of judgement.
